- RRSP Contributions made up to March 1st
- Child care expenses
- Union or professional dues

- Medical expenses for all family members
- Interest paid on loans for investment purposes
- Moving expenses incurred as a result of a change in job/school
- Home Buyers Plan withdrawals and repayments
- T2202A Tuition fees paid
- Spouse and dependents' income and expenses
- Adoption or fertility treatment costs
- First time homebuyers tax credit
- Renovate a dwelling for accessibility purposes for a senior or person who is disabled

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Employee stock option information
- Tax instalments paid towards income tax
- Property tax or rent paid in tax year
